Hooved Animal Rescue of Thurston County receives sickest animals in years, seeks community support

OLYMPIA, WA – The [Hooved Animal Rescue of Thurston County](http://www.har-otc.com) (HAROTC) received several horses from the Thurston County Sheriff's Office that will require months of rehabilitation before they will be healthy enough to adopt. The organization is seeking community support as expenses for the animals continue to grow.

"These are some of the sickest horses we've seen in years," said Kathy, "In just one week, our medical expenses have exceeded \$3,000 and that doesn't include bedding, feed, supplements, and other supplies."

HAROTC is a non-profit, all volunteer organization that assists local law enforcement when they seize abused and/or neglected hooved animals. The organization provides all the care and expenses for these animals, including vet, farrier, feed, bedding, and training, until the animals are released by the court and can be adopted. HAROTC relies on donations, community grants, and fundraisers to fund these efforts.

"It's going to be a long road for these horses," Kathy said. "We are asking for help from the community. No donation is too small, and all funds go directly to the animals. Without your support, we could not continue to help these animals, who cannot help themselves."
